MARCUS JACQUEZ EARNS ALL-STATE HONORS

Parishioner Marcus Jacques was honored for his outstanding season with the Fairmont Senior Polar Bear Football Team by being named first-team wide receiver on the Class AAA all-state football squad. He was the only Marion County player to be named to the AAA all-state first team. Capable of breaking a big play every time he touched the ball, Jacques did so with regularity in 2010. The senior finished the year with 64 catches, 1,034 receiving yards and 15 touchdowns. Jacques's yardage total broke the school single-season receiving mark set just last year by first-team all-state pick Aaron Fetty. Jacques was equally dangerous in the return game, averaging 29.8 yards on kickoffs and 18.2 yards on punts. He also scored twice on returns, bringing back a kickoff 95 yards for score against Morgantown and a punt 73 yards later in the year at Buckhannon-Upshur. Marcus, a senior this year, is also a track standout for Fairmont Senior.
